### **Job Description:**

### **Primary Responsibilities:**

- Repairs and maintains all components in light, medium and heavy duty trucks.
- Operate various manufacturer computer programs to run diagnostic tests.
- Diagnoses trouble codes, disassembles engines and other truck components, and examines parts for defects and excessive wear.
- Reconditions and replaces truck parts and components using, hand tools, pneumatic tools and precision measuring instruments.
- May weld and cut parts, using arc-welding and flame cutting equipment.
- Perform routine maintenance on trucks that are running properly: rotating tires, changing engine oil, replacing oil and fuel filters, inflating tires, replacing worn brake pads and shoes, and topping off fluids in the engine compartment.
- Work with a variety of tools on a daily basis including wrenches, screwdrivers, pliers, hoists, grinders and welding equipment as well as pneumatic and power tools.
- Handle and use tools in a safe manner.
- Perform annual state and federal safety inspections: checking safety equipment, including the glass, horn, brakes, tire tread and exterior lights.
- Perform emissions inspections/measure carbon emissions.
- Stay current on state and federal regulations and emissions codes.
